Hearing this breaks CALLIE's heart. She pulls her little sister in for a hug.

CALLIE
I know, and it'll never feel like any of us got long enough. Losing your brother is nothing anyone should have to go through. He was like the glue of this family. He kept all of us laughing and always made sure his little sisters were taken care of. He loved us so much.

(BEAT)
Whenever I felt upset, worried, anything, he would always sing this song for me. I know he would love for you to know it too.

CALLIE takes a breath and starts to sing "Million Little Miracles". As she's singing it keeps flipping between CALLIE and SADIE and CALLIE and BEN (19).

CALLIE

(singing)

*All my life, I've been carried by
grace. Don't ask my how cause I can't
explain. It's nothing short of a
miracle I'm here. I think it over and
it doesn't add up. I know it comes from
above. I've got miracles on miracles, a
million little miracles.
I've got miracles on miracles count
your miracles, 1-2-3-4 I can't even
count em all.*

CALLIE

Ok so now you have to sing it with me.
You got it?

CALLIE & SADIE

*I've got miracles on miracles, a
million little miracles.
I've got miracles on miracles count
your miracles, 1-2-3-4 I can't even
count em all.*

CALLIE and SADIE smile and SADIE leans into her sister. CALLIE knows that now this could be somewhat healing to SADIE. She knows BEN would be super happy.

SADIE

I really like that song.

CALLIE

Me too.

(BEAT)

Whenever you feel any sort of way, sing
that song and know that everything is
going to be alright. I won't tell mom
you were up this late but you really
need to go to bed.

SADIE

Ok...thank you Callie. I feel a lot
better.

CALLIE

Good.

SADIE goes to leave the room and CALLIE stops her.

CALLIE

Hey, one last thing. Ben was always so proud of you. I am too.

SADIE

Thanks. Love you Cal.
